

INJURY TO A DOG

Right at stop sign onto Old San Pasqual. Left at light onto Hwy 78. Left onto 17th /Felicita. Left at light onto Escondido Blvd (road narrows), clinic is on the left.


DIRECTIONS TO ACTION K9 SPORTS FROM I-15

Take exit 27/Via Rancho Parkway

Go for 0.6 m
Go for 0.3 m
Go for 2.9 m
Go for 1.6 m

Arrive at 15671 Old Milky Way, turn Left into the dirt road for Action K9 Sports

Park along the dirt road, **DO NOT** enter into the gates.



Level 3 HRD Course - Saturday

- 1. Handler and dog at handlers post by Bridge. Handler sends dog from their side to gather 5 sheep.
- 2. Handler directs dog to move sheep through Fetch Panels, after the sheep pass through the Fetch Panels, bring sheep to handler at the top of Bridge
- 3. Handler, dog and all 5 sheep must go over Bridge.
- 4. After the Bridge, proceed to Y-Chute. Handler may choose either side to stand to help. The handler can not move from that side until the last sheep enters the Y-Chute. Once all sheep go through, head to shed ring.
- 5. Bring sheep to Shed Ring area to shed off any 2 sheep. Then pen those two sheep.
- 6. Set-up dog for a look back to gather 5 more sheep. After sheep are lifted, fetch them through the Drive Away Panels and join the 5 sheep with the other 3 sheep.
- 7. With all 8 sheep, start the driveaway to the Drive Away Panels with all 8 sheep. After passing the Drive Away Panels, start the cross-drive towards the natural obstacle (river bed). Must keep sheep between the two trees. After the sheep move over the natural obstacle, bring the sheep to the road, and walk them on the road back towards the pen. Handler will stay at Pen.
- 8. Once the 8 sheep get to the pen, let the 2 sheep out of the Pen, and head towards the Duck Arena.
- 9. The handler, dog and sheep will walk to the Duck Arena Gate. The handler and the dog will do a hold of the gate. Judge will call the hold. After the hold, let sheep into arena. The run is complete.



Level 2 HRD Course Description - Saturday

- 1. Handler and dog will go into the Duck Arena and gather up 5 sheep. Then proceed to Footbath.
- 2. Handler will then bring the 5 sheep through the Footbath, then let all 5 sheep into the Main Arena. The handler can leave top of footbath once last sheep goes through. handler is allow to help dog push sheep through.
- 3. Handler and Dog will go into Pen #2 and take out 10 sheep and bring them into the Duck Arena. Handler must stay at the gate, while the dog pulls the sheep out.
- 4. Then do a Hold anywhere in the Duck Arena. Once the Judge calls a hold, proceed to the gate and sort any 5 sheep into the Main Arena.
- 5. Take the remain 5 and put in Trailer.
- 6. Handler and dog will go into the Main Arena. Handler will place dog at Handler's Post. The handler may stay at the Handler's Post to send their dog or walk half way to the sheep before sending their dog.
- 7. Fetch the sheep to the Handler's Post. Move the sheep counter clockwise around the post and start the drive away towards the barrels. Handler must stay at the Post until the sheep pass through the barrels.
- 8. Handler will meet the dog and sheep at the top of the Chute. Handler can help push sheep through chute is they get stuck.
- 9. Proceed to the Y-Chute and move all sheep through Y-Chute.
- 10. Handler will stay at the top of the Y-Chute, during the crossdrive through Barrels #2 and to the fence. The handler can leave the y-chute when the sheep get to the fence.
- 11. Handler and dog will do a hold off the gate before repenning the sheep.



Level 1 HRD Course Description - Saturday

Level 1 Handler may walk eveywhere. They can not enter the Chute or Footbath.

- 1. Handler and dog will go into the Duck Arena on leas and remove sheep before setting their dog up to gather 5 sheep. Then bring the 5 sheep through the Footbath, after let all 5 sheep into the Main Arena. Handler can help push sheep through Footbath.
- 2. Handler and Dog will go into Pen #2 and take out 10 sheep and bring them into the Duck Arena. Handler can assist in getting sheep out of pen but can not touch theor dog. Once back into the Duck Arena, do a Hold. The Judge will call the hold.
- 3. Bring the ten sheep to the Main Arena gate and sort any 5 sheep into the arena. Leave the remaining 5 in the Duck arena. The stock setters will remove stock.
- 4. Handler and dog will go into the Main Arena. Handler will place dog at Fetch Panels. The handler may stay at the Fecth Panels to send their dog from their side or walk half way to the sheep before sending their dog.
- 5. Fetch the sheep to the Handler's Post. Move the sheep counter clockwise around the handlers post and start towards the barrels.
- 6. After Barrels, move towrds the Chute. Handler can help dog push sheep through Chute.
- 7. Proceed to the Y-Chute.
- 8. After the last sheep enters the Y-Chute, the handler may leave and start walking between Barrel's #2 to the fence. Then proceed to re-pen gate.
- 9. Handler and dog will do a hold off the Re-Pen Gate before repenning the sheep






HRD III Course Description

- 1. Starting in the field. Dog and Handler to the Handler's Post; Handler will send dog from their side either direction.
- 2. Gather the 10 sheep and bring them through Panel #1.
- 3. Then move your sheep into Arena #1.
- 4. Sort 5 marked sheep into Arena #2.
- 5. Take sorted sheep directly to Y-chute; handler must stay at Y-Chute and drive sheep through the Long Chute.
- 6. Dog drives all sheep into the Long Chute; dog enters the chute sufficiently to hold the sheep. Handler then may leave the "Y" to open the gate at exit end of the chute. The dog must push all sheep through the chute and exit after them. All sheep and dog must transit chute before proceeding on course. Exhaust sheep into Exhaust Pen.
- 7. Return to Arena #1, gather the other 5 sheep into Arena #2 and take them to the 3-sided inspection Hold Pen. The Judge will say when you can remove the sheep from the Hold Pen.
- 8. After completion of inspection, take sheep from Hold Pen, head to Arena #1 and move back into the field.
- 9. Handler will stay at the handlers Post and drive sheep through Panel #2 and crossdrive around Cone #1.
- 10. Handler may leave post and proceed to trailer after crossdrive.
- 11. Load sheep onto the free standing trailer. Remember to close the door. Course is now completed.

Tiebreaker: (1) Drive long chute (2) sort into arena (3) Time

Time: 18 minutes




HRD Level II Course:

- 1. Handler and dog go into Sorting Pens and take out 10 sheep.
- 2. Puts those 10 sheep into Arena #1.
- 3. Handler and dog will bring the 10 sheep to the gate to start sorting.
- 4. Sort 5 sheep; two will be marked into Arena #2. If you're having trouble sorting, the handler may use Sorting Pens to put and leave the unwanted sheep in.
- 5. Once all sheep are in Arena #2, dog and handler will go into Arena #2 and make sure the sheep are on the hay. There will be hay in the arena and the sheep should naturally go to the hay.
- 6. Place dog at Post 2; handler can go 1/2 way to sheep.
- 7. Send dog, either direction to gather sheep.
- 8. Handler, dog, and sheep will walk up to and around Post #2 then head to the Y-Chute.
- 9. Once the Y-Chute is completed, the handler must stay at the Y-Chute and drive sheep to the Long Chute. Handler may proceed to Long Chute when the first sheep reaches the opening. All sheep must go into the chute and the dog must be in the chute sufficiently to hold the sheep. The handler opens the gate at the exit and dog must stay in the chute and push all sheep through the exit gate
- 10. When the Long Chute is completed, the Handler will stay at the Long Chute and drive sheep through Cone #1 and Cone #2.
- 11. Once the last sheep pass the cones, the handler can leave and head to the Exhaust Pen to pen sheep.
- 12. Go back to Arena #1 and gather the 5 sheep into Arena #2.
- 13. Proceed to the 3-sided inspection Holding Pen. The Judge will let you know when you can let them out, then proceed back to Arena #1
- 14. Once in Arena #1, load sheep into trailer. Remember to close the door.

The course is now complete.

Tiebreaker: (1) Drive to the long chute (2) Sort marked sheep (3) Time

Time: 12 minutes



HRD I Course Description:

- 1. Handler and dog go into Sorting Pens and to take out 10 sheep.
- 2. Puts those ten sheep into Arena #1.
- 3. Handler and dog will bring the 10 sheep to the gate to start sorting.
- 4. Sort any 5 sheep into Arena #2. If you're having trouble sorting, the handler may use the Sorting Pens to put and leave any unwanted sheep in.
- 5. Once all sheep are in Arena #2, dog and handler will go into Arena #2 and make sure that the sheep are on the hay. There will be hay in the arena and the sheep should naturally go to the hay.
- 6. Place dog at Post 1; handler can go to within 15 feet of sheep.
- 7. Send dog, either direction to gather sheep.
- 8. Handler, dog, and sheep will walk up to and around Post #2 then head to the Y-Chute.
- 9. Once the Y-Chute is completed, proceed to Long Chute. Help your dog move the sheep through the Long Chute. Dog must follow sheep through Chute.
- 10. After Long Chute, start walking towards and through, Cone #1 and Cone #2.
- 11. Then proceed to Exhaust Pen to pen sheep.
- 12. Go back to Arena #1 and gather the 5 sheep you left, and bring those 5 sheep into Arena #2.
- 13. Proceed to the 3-sided inspection Holding Pen. The Judge will let you know when you can let them out, then proceed back to Arena #1
- 14. Once in Arena #1, load sheep into trailer. Remember to close the door.

The course is now complete.
